ROLF'S PERSEVERENCE PAYS OFF

ALBURY'S glaucoma campaigner, Mr Rolf Kaiser, is relentless in his mission for public awareness of the eye disease.

His fundraising efforts of the past few years enabled him to present the Glaucoma Foundation of Australia, which he founded in 1986, with a cheque for \$1751.

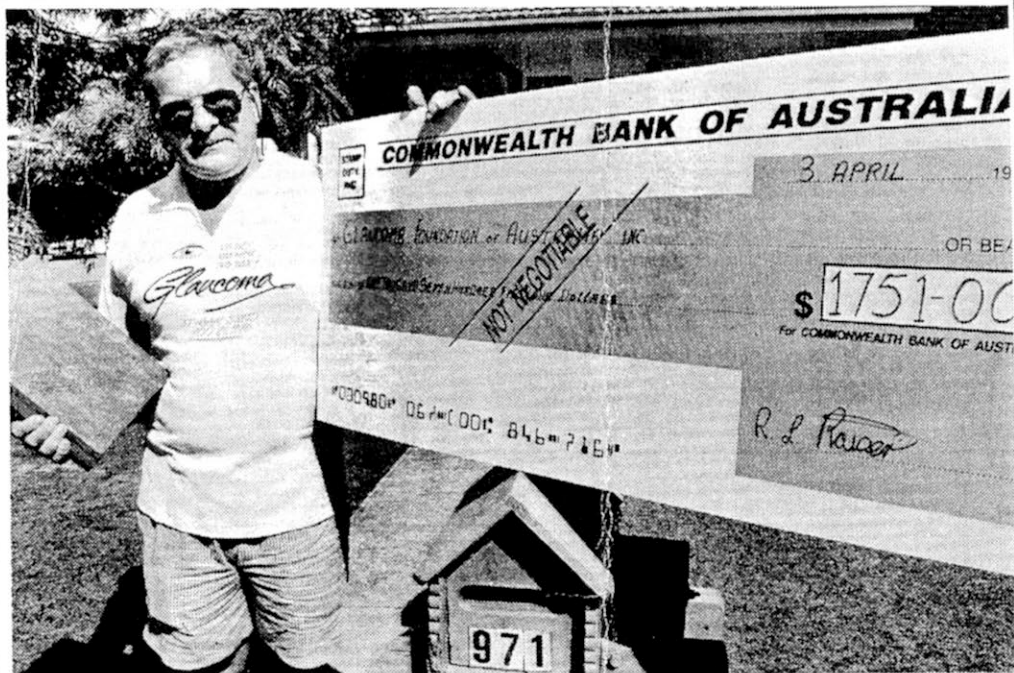
A sufferer for many years, Mr Kaiser also has inspired his son Eric to take on the cause.

Eric Kaiser, 28, a student of Geelong's Deakin University, has spent the past year in Canberra researching the politics of preventative eye care in Australia.

Eric's efforts have earned him a first class honors degree and a post-graduate research scholarship for a masters degree.

"Eric's thesis is highly critical of the lack of awareness and knowledge of glaucoma in Australia," Mr Kaiser said yesterday.

"It is also critical of the medical profession and the politicians for letting it go on."
