It was quite a difficult decision to make, dissociating myself from an organisation of which I am the Founder.


The main reason for my resignation was, (a) the going away from the original concept of the first meeting of the Foundation of 3rd September, 1986. I find it unbelievable that the attitude has been turned around, and the Minutes of the first and second meetings disregarded; (b) in essence, the Committee wanted to effectively stop me from carrying on the work I started in April, 1986 consisting mainly of publicity and my trip around Australia in an awareness campaign, and fund raising.

Without going into further detail, you are well aware of the Minutes, and you are aware of the objection I raised.

I challenge the legality of the Glaucoma Foundation as being a charity. No charity will allow the supply of money for equipment for private individuals.

It is with regret I confirm my resignation.
